

Linda Brown, 12, Sets Swim Mark

At least eight hours of practice swimming a week has paid off for 12-year-old Linda Brown of Mayville.

Linda, a pretty blonde daughter of Ken Brown, fullback and co-captain of Cornell University's 1940 football team, Saturday afternoon set a National AAU swim record of 29.7 seconds in the 40-yard breaststroke event.

The 110-pound Chautauqua County girl, coached by Dick Bower, ex-Lafayette High School swimmer, shaved 1.3 seconds off the old record for girls 12 years old and under. She also won the 20-yard freestyle and 20-yard breaststroke (a simultaneous race with her record-setting time) in the midget girls' division as the City of Jamestown swimmers defeated the Town of Amherst team, 186-82, in the Park School outdoor pool.

Linda also won the 40-yard freestyle in the senior girls' division as many of the Jamestown swimmers shifted in class.

"She's very enthusiastic about swimming and learned at the age

of 7," said her proud father Sunday. Linda practices in Lake Chautauqua in the Summer and swims in the Jamestown YMCA in the Winter. Linda's 9-year-old sister, Diana, won the 20-yard freestyle in the peeewe girls' division and swam in the relay.

Bill Radack swept the 40 free, 100 free and 100-yard backstroke events in the unlimited boys' division and his brother, Jim, won the 40-free and 40-back and swam the relay in the junior boys' division. The winners follow:
