

Four Records Established In Y's Annual Cross-The-Lake Swim

Four records were established in the annual YMCA Cross-the-Lake swim Sunday, one being the 26:22 in the boys' 15 and 16-year-old division by Tom Lindsey, 15, of Pittsburgh. The mark also stands for men of all ages, according to Y Athletic Director Dick Bower. The old mark was 27:27. A field of 60 entries competed.

Linda Poole, 15, of Mt. Lebanon, Pa., also shattered the record of 38:49 with a 34:24 performance in the girls' 15 and 16 group and Patty Teehan, 13, of Allison Park, Pa., in the girls' 13 and 14 competition. Patty replaced the old record of 35:27 with a 30:51.

Sandy Lee Burry, 12, of New Wilmington, Pa., smashed the former girls' 12 and under record and also set an all-time record for women

in the event by covering the course in 29:16, eclipsing the former 33:31.

Laura Frost, 8-year-old Detroit lassie won the youngest-competitor trophy, also placing third in the 12 and under group.
