Red Sox In First Place At Half Season In Connie Mack Little League

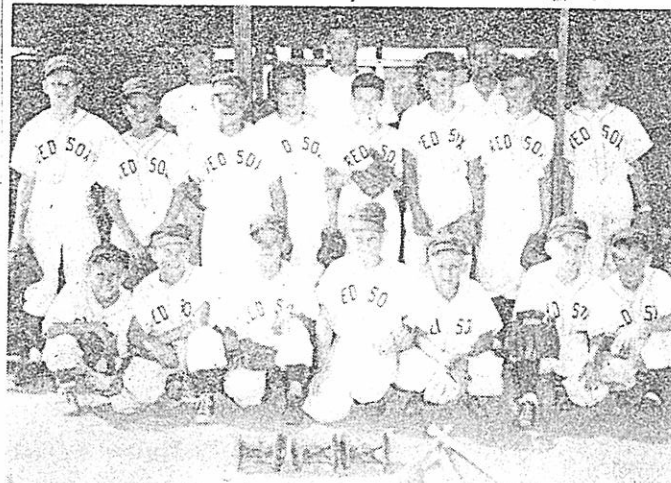

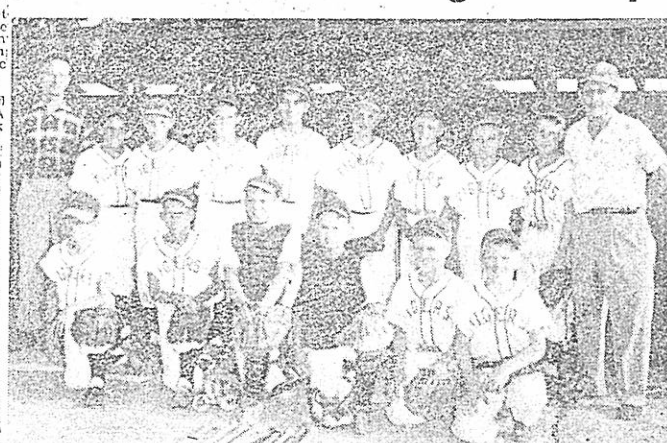
