

Amherst Swimmers Lose Dual Meet To Kenmore-Tonawanda

Town Swimmers Gain Places in Open A.A.U. Meet in Buffalo

Last Wednesday, the Amherst-Williamsville swimmers travelled to Lincoln Pool in Kenmore to enter the fourth annual meet with age-group swimmers of that area, and again the home team gained the Willard Eisenhardt Memorial Trophy by a score of 220-137.
