Young Rochester Finman Cracks 2 National Marks

Mike Austin of Rochester set two national records for boys 15 and 16 years old yesterday in the Courier-Express-Division of Recreation age group AAU Swim Meet at Schiller Pool. Austin, a 16-year-old high school graduate who will enter Yale University next month, broke national standards in the 100 and 200-yard freestyle events.

The smooth-stroking youngster did the 50 in :23, eclipsing the mark of :23.4 set by Steve Clark of the Pacific Assn. Clark's record of :52.9 in the 100 also went by the boards when Austin turned in a :52.8 performance.

Dick Williams of Homer, N.Y., a finalist in the U.S. Olympic trials, broke three Niagara District records for boys 15 and 16 years of age.

Williams set a 100-yard butterfly record of 1:00.5, a 200-yard freestyle mark of 2:07.8, and a 200-yard medley standard of 2:20.9.

Bob Levine, Pittsburgh, held the old 100 mark of 1:06.3. Don Gallizi, New York AC, formerly owned the 200-yard freestyle standard of 2:10.8, and Town of Tonawanda's Tim O'Hara had the 200-medley record of 2:28.

Two marks were broken by

Kerry O'Hara, of the Town of Tonawanda, in the 13 and 14 age bracket. O'Hara did the 100-yard backstroke in 1:06.5, then swam the 200-medley in 2:31.1.

One other boys' record was broken when John Edwards of Kensington swam the 100-yard freestyle in 1:08.4 to better a mark set for boys 11 and 12 years old last year of 1:09.0 by John Grys, Downton YMCA.

Six girls' records were set, two each by Betty Hushla and Janice Carnahan.

Miss Hushla, competing in the 13 and 14 years of age bracket, did the 100-yard freestyle in 1:06.8, to eclipse a mark of 1:10.7 set by Berta Schreiber of the Delaware YMCA in 1958. She then turned in a 1:14.9 performance in the 100 backstroke to better a 1:19.0 mark set by Andj Hopkins of Pittsburgh in 1959.

Miss Carnahan set two marks in the 11 and 12 years of age division. She did the 100-yard breaststroke in 1:35.7 to break her own record of 1:37.2, then broke her own mark of :43.6 in the 50-yard breaststroke with a time of :42.7.

Marianne Hushla broke the district record of :43.8 held by Virginia Greenwood of Hamilton, Ont., with a time of :43.0 in the 50-yard backstroke for girls 10 years and under.

Miss Schreiber, participating in the 100-yard freestyle for girls 15 and 16 years of age, turned in a time of 1:08.8 to break Amy Johnson's record of 1:09.1 set in 1953.

Don Kane was the meet director and Dr. J. C. Delaney was the executive consultant.
