

17 Records Smashed

Amherst Second in Fifth Eisenhardt Meet

The fifth annual Eisenhardt meet ran true to form as 17 Niagara AAU district age-group records were broken, with Amherst swimmers responsible for five. The Amherst-Williamsville "A" team made its best showing in the history of this invitation meet as they garnered 104 points to place second to the usual run-away Tonawanda-Kenmore "A" which displayed greater strength in the older age groups to amass 132 points for first place and the Eisenhardt Memorial trophy.

With the meet almost half over last Tuesday, the Ken-Ton team moved into the breaststroke events and took six out of eight first-places for the lead which it held to the end. The City of Tonawanda gained 76 points for third, City of North Tonawanda and Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda "B" tied with 48 points with the Amherst "B" team earning 21 points to close out the scoring.

The 11-12-year-old girls' relay team, composed of Eileen Zaepfel, Nancy Zaepfel, Sue Mols, and Pat Dudley, set a new record in the 200-meter relay. Pat also accounted for the 50-meter freestyle record. This same team, with Lana Kaiser in place of Sue, set the only District record in the recent Town championships at Park School.

Dale Neuberger continued his assault on the record book as he set the new 25-meter backstroke record for boys 10 and under, as well as aiding his relay team of Chuck Steffens, John Corbett, and Gerard Lucas to establish a new mark in the 100-meter relay. Ruth Edwards completed the Amherst record-breaking with a new mark in the 200-meter individual medley. Ruth also established a meet record by winning the 50-meter butterfly.
