

Junior Olympics Close Spectacular Week As One National, Six Local Records Topple

ONE national and six local records toppled Saturday in the Erie County Track & Field Championships to make a fitting finale for Junior Olympic Week.

Kathy Krajewski, running as if she had wings on her heels,

clipped a tenth of a second off the Senior Girls (16-18) 75-yard sprint with a brilliant 8.5-second performance on the Amherst Central School field. It climaxed a sensational JO career for the mercury-footed miss who, through the years, shattered

several sprint marks in all divisions.

Sharing the spotlight with Miss Krajewski, who hopes to study medicine when school starts in the fall, were Ray Mingle of West Seneca and Dick Swygert of Lackawanna. Both were double-event winners. And both were record-breakers.

Mingle Lowers Mark for 100

Swygert set a new mark in the Junior Boys (13-14) running broad jump with a leap of 16 feet 6 3/4 inches, an increase of 6 1/4 inches over the old mark. He also won the 50-yard dash in 6.7 seconds.

Mingle sliced five-tenths of a second off the Junior Boys' 100-yard mark with an 11.3 effort. He also triumphed in the 12-inch softball throw with a toss of 227 feet 10 inches.

There were three other record-breakers:

Clarence Allen of Willert Playground broke the Midget Boys (11 years and under) Softball-

throwing record by 2 feet 2 inches with a 192-foot toss.

Delbert Mullens of Sperry Playground took 1.1 seconds off the Intermediate (14-15) Boys 220-yard mark by doing it in 23.2.

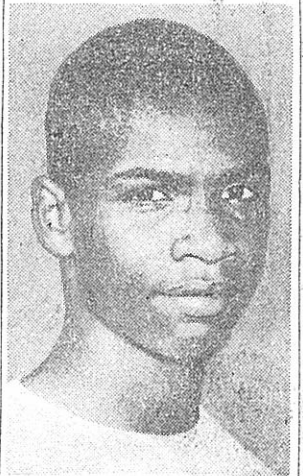
Willert Boys Set Record

John Paske of Dewey Playground lengthened the Intermediate 8-pound shot-put standard by 4 feet 2 inches with a toss of 58-1.

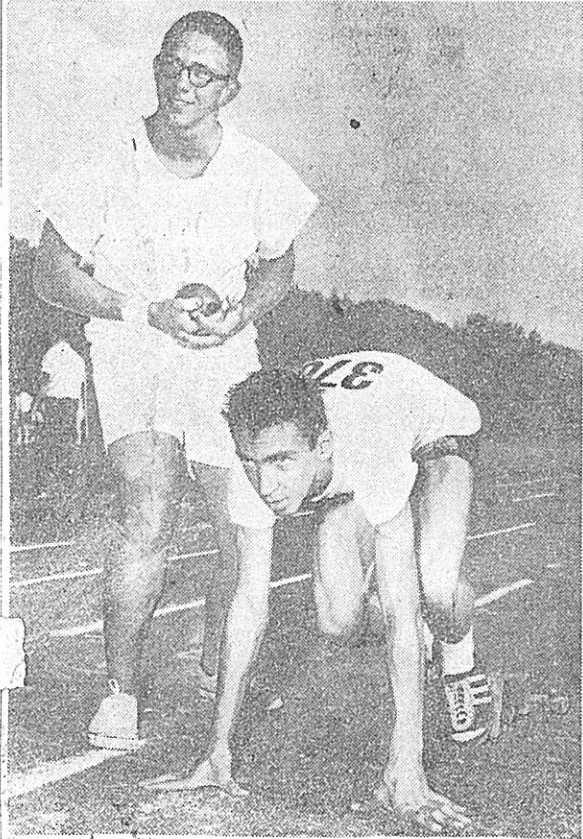
Willert Playground's Junior Boys 220-relay team clipped seven tenths of a second off the old standard with a 25.7 time. The quartet was composed of James Brown, Ed Clemens, Dave Woods, George Curry.

More than 2000 spectators were on hand to watch the final attraction on the week-long Junior Olympic Week Program sponsored by The Buffalo Evening News in co-operation with the Erie County and City Recreation Departments.

The program opened with Susan Ronk, seventh-grade pupil at Sweet Home School, reciting the JO pledge. Competing for Amherst, she later triumphed in the Junior Girls 50-yard dash.
