Comprising the league will be the Harley School of Rochester; Lakemont Academy, Lakemont, N. Y.; the Park School of Buffalo and Pebble Hill School.

Attending the meeting were Henry P. Gilland, headmaster of Lakemont Academy; Herbert J. Mols, athletic director of the Park School; Lansing W. McDowell, athletic director of the Harley School; Thompson D. Grant, assistant headmaster of Pebble Hill School; John G. Hodgdon, and Joseph D. Krol, coaches at Pebble Hill.

The purpose of the league will be to promote athletic competition, and, to a certain extent, social relationships among the four schools. Baseball and track meets are planned.

**PARK SCHOOL JOINS

"Sports without fighting" will be the theme of the newly-organized Conference of Upstate Private Schools (CUPS), formed under the direction of Herbert J. Mols, athletic director of the Park School of Buffalo.

Park School, with a registration of 40 boys at its Snyder location, will compete against Harley School of Rochester, Lakemont Academy and Pebble Hill School of DeWitt. The four schools have been playing informally in basketball, with Lakemont undefeated in three games and Park School having won two of four starts. Park School will play at Harley March 1.

CUPS also will stage a track and field meet at Harley in May and each member also may play one baseball game with a possibility of six-man football next Fall. Park School, which lost to Lakemont, 64 to 30, but defeated Pebble Hill, 44 to 38, last week-end, will play a nonleague at-home basketball game Friday at 3:30 P. M. with Neumann High of Williamsville.
