**Park School Tumbles
Pebble Hill, 22 to 14**

Park School opened its Conference of Upstate Private Schools six-man football campaign with a 22-14 victory over Pebble Hill of Syracuse yesterday.

Park's touchdowns were scored by Fred Carl on a 15-yard run, Bill Bridge on a 45-yard pass play with Jim Hufford pitching and Dick Carl on a 40-yard aerial strike from Hufford. The latter converted twice, each conversion being worth two points. Pebble Hill's touchdowns came on Al Wiscrup-to-Bob Edwards passes of five and 30 yards, Wiscrup dropkicking one conversion.

**Hufford Is Keyman for Park
In 6-Man Football Win**

Park School of Buffalo defeated Harley School of Rochester, 48 to 14, at Snyder Friday afternoon to score its third win in the Conference of Upstate Private Schools Six-Man Football League. Jim Hufford figured in 30 of Park's points, scoring two touchdowns, passing for two others and dropkicking three two-point conversions. **Park Subdues OLV
In 6-Man Football, 15-6**

Park School's six-man football team yesterday chalked up its seventh victory of the season and tenth straight over a two-year span by defeating Our Lady of Victory, 15 to 6, at Park. The only LV score came in the opening period, on a 20-yard pass from Vince Mescall to George Check.

Park also tallied a touchdown in the opening period, a Bill Bridge-to-Jim Hufford aerial play covering 40 yards. In the third period Park Capt. Gord Gross tackled an OLV runner behind the goal line for a safety, and Park added an unneeded tally in the fourth canto when Jim Hufford passed to Warren MacKenzie for a 50-yard score. The same combination added the extra point on a pass. Two Hufford touchdown jaunts in the fourth period were called back because of penalties.

**Park School Wallops
Harley in 48-14 Rout**

Jim Hufford paced Park School to its third straight Conference of Upstate Private Schools six-man football victory at Snyder yesterday, tossing two scoring passes and tallying two touchdowns himself in an easy 48-14 victory over Harley of Rochester. Fred Carl also counted twice for Park, with Dick Carl, Bill Bridge and Perry Check collecting the other six-pointers. Hufford also dropkicked all three of Park's conversions, each worth two points.

Pete Keller and Ken Frankel counted for Harley, with Steve May adding the only conversion.
