

PARK SCHOOL TEAMS GAIN 2 LOOP TITLES

Park School of Buffalo retained its six-man football and its track-and-field championships in the Conference of Upstate Private Schools in 1949. The gridders won seven games, extending their undefeated string to 17 the last three years. In CUPS basketball, the Snyder school tied for fourth, finished runner-up to Pebble Hill of Syracuse in baseball while the soccer team won one game.

Park's girls' field hockey team was undefeated, winning 12 games, tying 2. The girls' basketball team also had a fine record. Park athletes named on all-star CUPS teams included:
