

Park School Wins Quadrangular Meet

The Park School of Snyder, paced by sprinter Pete Dow and field event star Terry Cheek, defeated Nichols School, Allendale School of Rochester and Lakemont (N. Y.) Academy in a quadrangular meet yesterday at Nichols Field.

Park, winning eight of the 12 events, amassed 72 points to outdistance easily its three rivals. Nichols was second with 50 1/6 points, Allendale third with 4 1/2, and Lakemont 3 1/3.

Cheek registered an individual triple, while Dow scored a double and had a finger in Park's 880-yard relay win.

Cheek took the shot put with a heave of 42 feet, 11 1/2 inches, the broad jump with a leap of 18 feet, 2 1/2 inches, and the high jump with a 5 feet, 5 3/4 inches effort. Dow won the 220 in :24.8 and the 100 in :10.5, then teamed with Joe Scandura, Bill Bridge and Bob Loffler to take the 880 relay.

Nichols athletes won the other four events—Bill Magavern the 440 in :57, Ted Howard the 880 in 2:17.6, Russ Pickering the pole vault and Lane Montesano the discus throw. The summaries:

CHEEK AGAIN PLAYS TOP ROLE; PACES PARK'S TRACK WIN

Terry Cheek, who the day before had pitched Park School's baseball team to a win over Allendale of Rochester, Saturday won three events to pace Park to victory over Allendale, Nichols and Lakemont Academy in a track meet at Nichols Field.

Park won eight of the 12 events for 72 points. Nichols, winner of the other four events, finished with 50 1/6, to 4 1/2 for Allendale and 3 1/3 for Lakemont. Cheek won the shot put, broad jump and high jump. Winners follow:

Park School Wins Third Track Title In Rochester Meet

Rochester, May 27—Park School of Snyder amassed 156 points in the fourth annual Conference of Upstate Private Schools track and field meet this afternoon to capture the Syracuse Cup for the third straight season.

The trophy, awarded by the Syracuse alumni, automatically becomes the property of the school that wins the championship three seasons in a row.

In the Senior events, Park amassed 100 1/2 points by winning nine of the 11 events and added four first places in the Junior series.

Allendale, the host school, placed second with 85 points. Lakemont Academy was third with 79. Harley School of Rochester fourth with 48, and Pebble Hill of Syracuse fifth with 11 points.

Bill Bridge, Pete Dow and Terry Cheek each walked off with two first places for Park School and, along with Joe Scandura, who had two second places, won the 880-relay in 1:36.8.

Leon Shippey, a 14-year-old freshman, won the 100-hurdles in the junior series in :14.3, finished first in the pole vault with a leap of 6 feet, 6 inches, and ran first leg of the winning 440-relay team.
