

## CUPS SPORTS LOOP AWARDS MEMBERSHIP TO DEVEAUX SCHOOL

DeVeaux School of Niagara Falls has been accepted into the Conference of Upstate Private Schools, according to an announcement today by Herbert J. Mole, director of athletics at the Park School of Buffalo and 1950-51 CUPS sports chairman.

The CUPS unanimously approved the acceptance of DeVeaux at an athletic directors meeting at Allendale School, Rochester, Saturday. DeVeaux will begin sports competition this Fall in six-man football and soccer under the guidance of Kenneth W. Anthony, athletic director.

The Niagara Falls School, with an enrollment of 75 boys, is completing its seventh season in the Niagara-Orleans County High School League during which time they have won two basketball and one baseball championships.

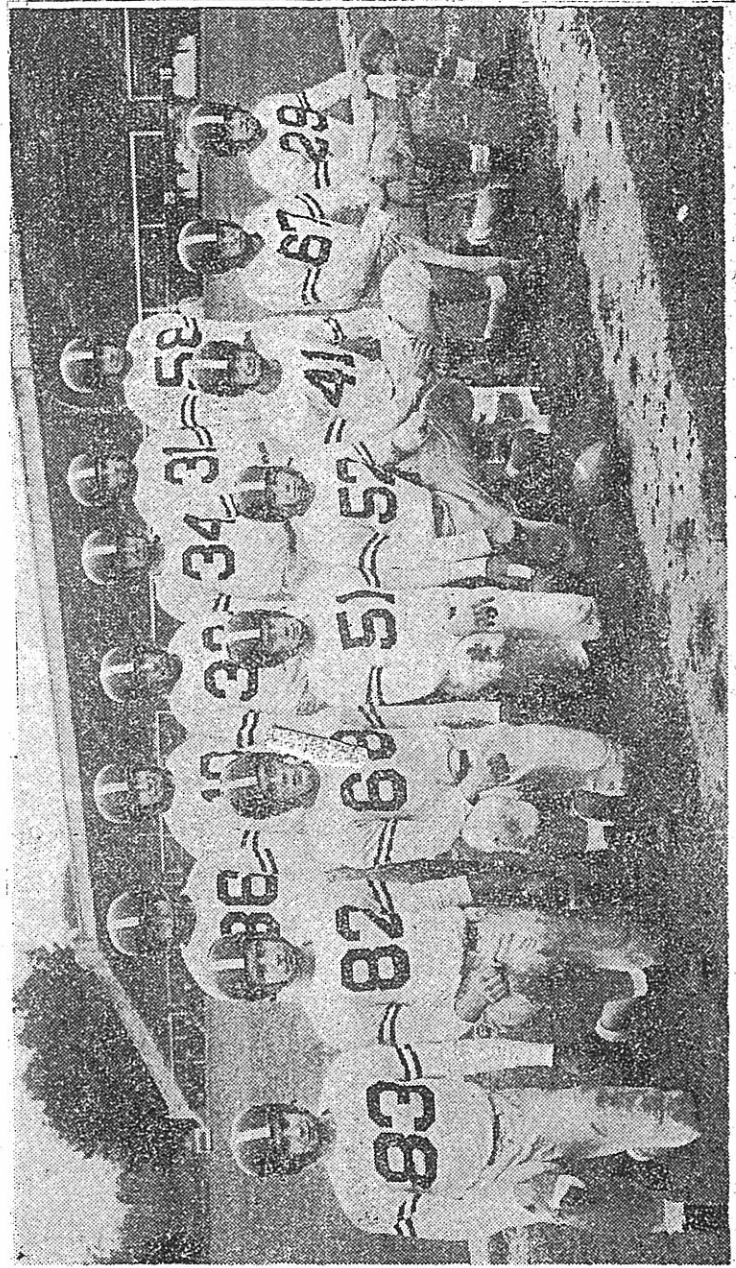
Park, Harley, Lakemont and Pebble Hill of Syracuse are charter members of the CUPS, organized by Mr. Mole in 1947. Allendale was added in 1949.

DeVeaux, which last year discontinued its traditional military program, will participate in CUPS basketball, baseball and track competition. The school also will have golf and tennis matches on an independent schedule.
