

Park Tops Alumni In 65-57 Tilt

A 40-point production by Steve Cary and Jerry Jacobstein sparked Park School's basketball team to a 65-57 triumph over an alumni quintet yesterday at Park's gymnasium.

Cary netted 23 points and Jacobstein 17 as Park, down by an 18-12 count after one quarter, rallied to take a 35-28 halftime command. The alumni never caught up.

Bob Wilson, a junior at North-western and a member of the Wildcat's wrestling team, paced the alumni with 30 points. Tim Finnell, a freshman at Colgate, contributed 12.

The victory evened Park's record at 1-1.

Steve Cary, who collected 52 points over the three games, including a 27-point performance against Allendale, sparked the local cagers who led the conference race.

Cary collected 17 against St. Mary's, with Jerry Jacobstein and Barry Epstein sharing the supporting role with 14 apiece. Mark Smith won scoring honors in the one-sided conquest of Harley School with 13 points. Epstein added 11 as the Park scoring was spread over 11 players. Jacobstein followed Cary in the Allendale win, throwing in 13.

Park will travel to DeVeaux School of Niagara Falls for a C.U.P.S. game Friday that could decide the Cornell Cup. At present, DeVeaux has a record of 4-1 and a win by Park would clinch the championship.
