Park School successfully defended its Conference of Upstate Private Schools basketball championship last week by chalking up its sixth and seventh straight victories in league competition. Park up-ended Allendale, 61-51, and slammed last-place Harley, 63-29.

The repeat victory enabled Park to secure a second leg on the Cornell Cup, emblematic of CUPS supremacy. Allendale also holds two legs. The first school to gain the third leg will retire the trophy.
