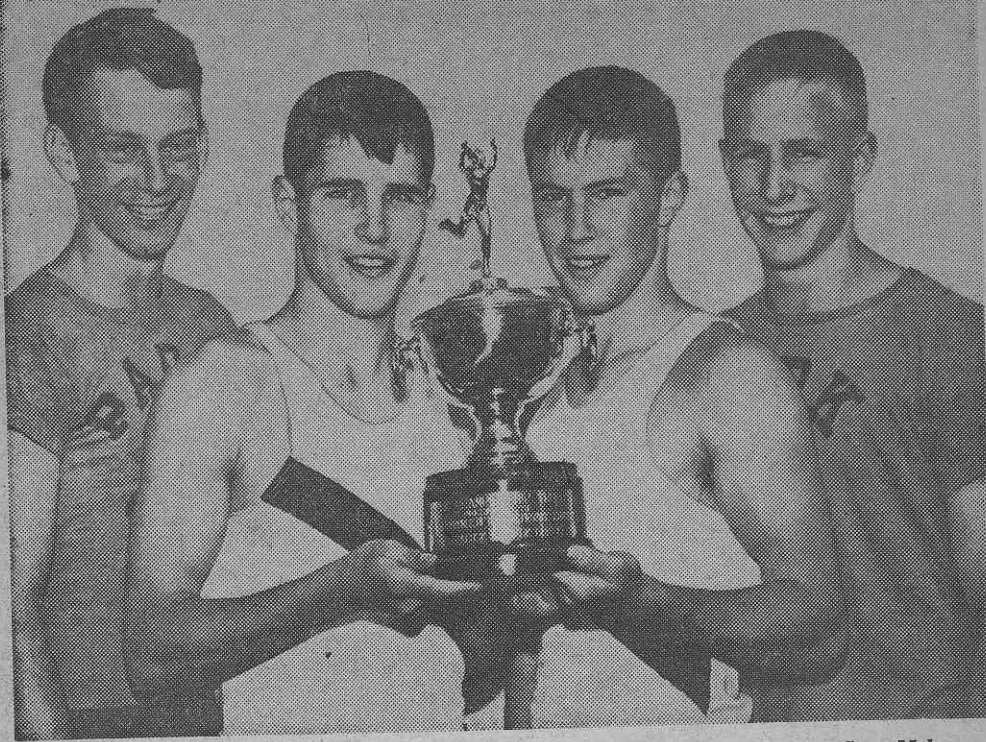

Winners in annual CUPS track meet at Park School

Allendale Cindermen Win To Retain Syracuse Trophy

Allendale of Rochester successfully defended the Syracuse Cup, emblematic of the CUPS track and field senior-junior championship, Saturday at Park School.

The Rochester school totaled 178½ points to 167 for Park, 45½ for DeVeaux, 36½ for Pebble Hill and 19 for Harley.

Bill George of the winners won the 100-yard dash, the 100 hurdles, the hop step and jump and ran a leg on the winning half-mile relay, Leo Simpson

won the half mile and pole vault and also ran a leg on the relay.

In the junior meet, Park's Gary Mols took the 50, 100 and hop-step and jump and ran a leg on the winning 440 relay. Pete Lechner of Park took the high jump, 100 hurdles, broad jump and also ran on the relay team.

Allendale also won the midget and cubs competition.

MOLS, LECHNER LEAD PARK SCHOOL IN CUPS TRACK

Junior Division entrants Gary Mols and Pete Lechner both scored three victories and ran on host Park School's victorious 440-yard relay team in Saturday's Conference of Upstate Private Schools Track Championships.

The over-all title was retained by Allendale of Rochester with 178 5/6 points. Park scored 167 points, DeVeaux of Niagara Falls, 45½; Pebble Hill of Syracuse, 36½, and Harley of Rochester, 19.

Mols won the junior 50-yard dash in 6 seconds, the 100 in :11.2 and set a CUPS hop, step and jump record of 39 feet 3½ inches.

Lechner high-jumped to a Junior CUPS mark of 5 feet ¾ inch, set a running broad-jump junior record of 19 feet ½ inch, and won the 100-yard hurdles in :12.8.

Park's only Senior Division victors were Chip Johnston, 440 in :56.3, and Phil Marshall, 18-6, in the running broad-jump.
