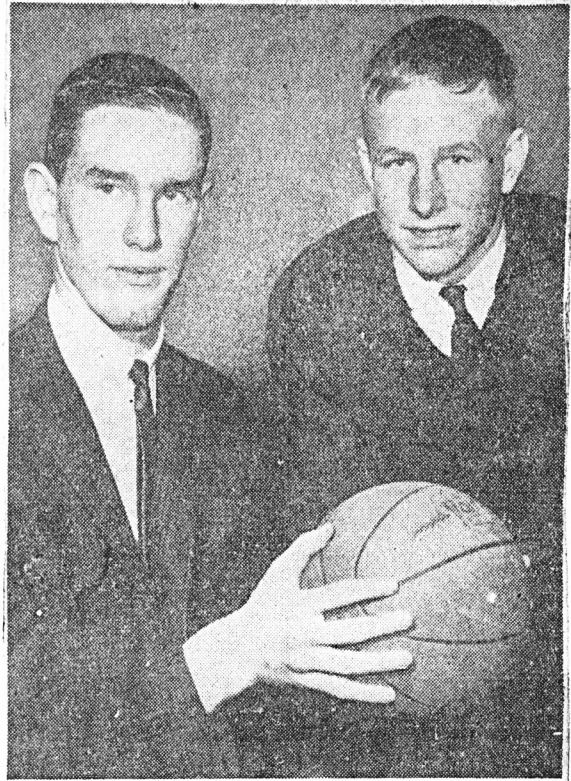

Two players from the Park School today were selected on the all-star basketball team of the Conference of Upstate Private Schools. They are Gary Mols and James Derrick, both juniors.

Others on the first team selected by the players and coaches are Tom Tenny of Allendale, the only repeater from last season; Tom Miller of Allendale and Tom Ferrante of Pebble Hill.

Derrick was the high average scorer for the season with 17.4 points a game. Phil Marshall and Pete Lechner of Park earned honorable mention along with: Mark Duoman of Allendale; Mike Todd and Jon Feltner of Harley, and Charles Heer and Bill Huntley of Pebble Hill.

# Park Skiers Win Junior Olympics

Park School of Buffalo won the team title at the Junior Winter Olympics Saturday at Glenwood Acres ski center with a total of 17 points. The victory gives Park possession of the rotating Ski Rack trophy for another year.

Park's John Mayer was outstanding skier in the meet, in which 12 school groups have been taking skiing as an intramural activity this winter competed.

Mayer won both the slalom and giant slalom races in the experienced class and took possession of the Dennis Brown Trophy.

Mayer ran the giant slalom course in a speedy 31.1 seconds. Pete Waterman of Park was close behind at 31.6 and Jerry Knapp of Springville Central third in 31.8.

In the 25-gate slalom, Mayer finished in 32 seconds, Knapp in 32.2 and Waterman in 33.7. Course conditions were excellent, a foot of fresh snow having fallen overnight.
