The Park School Friday was a double winner in sports competitions against Gow School at Park.

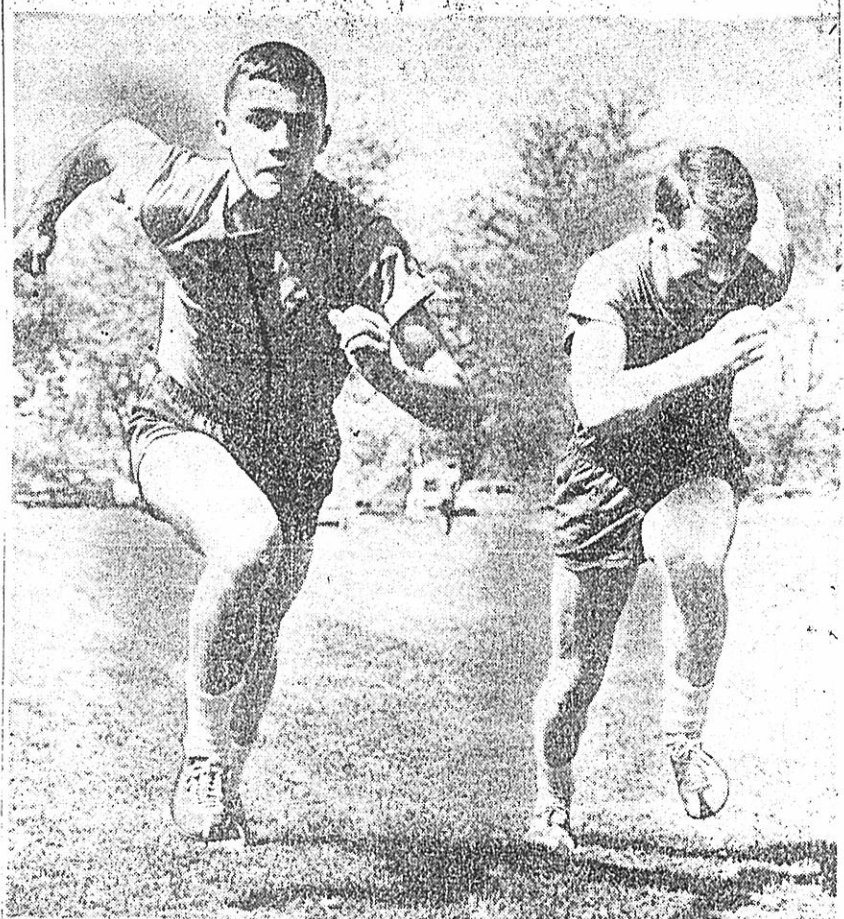
The Park baseball team scored a 9-1 victory with Phil Marshall the winning pitcher. Marshall drove out a double and two singles good for two runs-batted-in.
