

Park Skiers Take Title

The Park School ski team, paced by Gary Sidell and Dave Carter, won the ninth annual Conference of Upstate Private Schools ski meet Saturday at Glenwood Acres.

Sidell won the slalom and Carter finished second with Jim Capps of Pebble Hill third. Carter copped first in the giant slalom with Dave Tuthill of Harley second and Sidell third.

The overall scoring gave Park 410.5 to 386 for Allendale, 377 for Pebble Hill and 309 for Harley.

In the slalom, Allendale of Rochester, the defending overall champion, totaled 193.5 points to 180.5 for Park. Pebble Hill was third with 172 and Harley fourth with 165. In the giant slalom scoring, Park had 230, Pebble Hill 205, Allendale 192.5 and Harley 144.

It was Park's fourth leg in nine years on the Fred Dunn Memorial Trophy.

Ed Morris Leads Gow Ski Victory

Ed Morris, student-coach-skier, took first place Friday to lead Gow School to a dual meet victory over the Park School at Gow's ski slope.

Morris was clocked in a total of 76 seconds in two runs at an open gate slalom course. George Clark of Gow was second in 81 seconds and Gary Sidell of Park was third in 86.5 seconds.

Gow won the event on a total-time-elapsed basis, 440.75 seconds to 537.50 seconds.

Allendale Rips Park, 101 to 27

Allendale School of Rochester handed Park School a shattering 101-27 basketball setback Friday in a CUPS game played at Park. Jim Criticos scored 50 points for the visitors, a conference individual high scoring record.

The victory gives Allendale a 4-0 record in conference play while Park is now 2-1.

Other double-figure men for the winners were Richard Kendall with 16 points and Tom Perez with 11. Larry Lewis was high man for the losers with eight points.
