TOP REBOUNDER

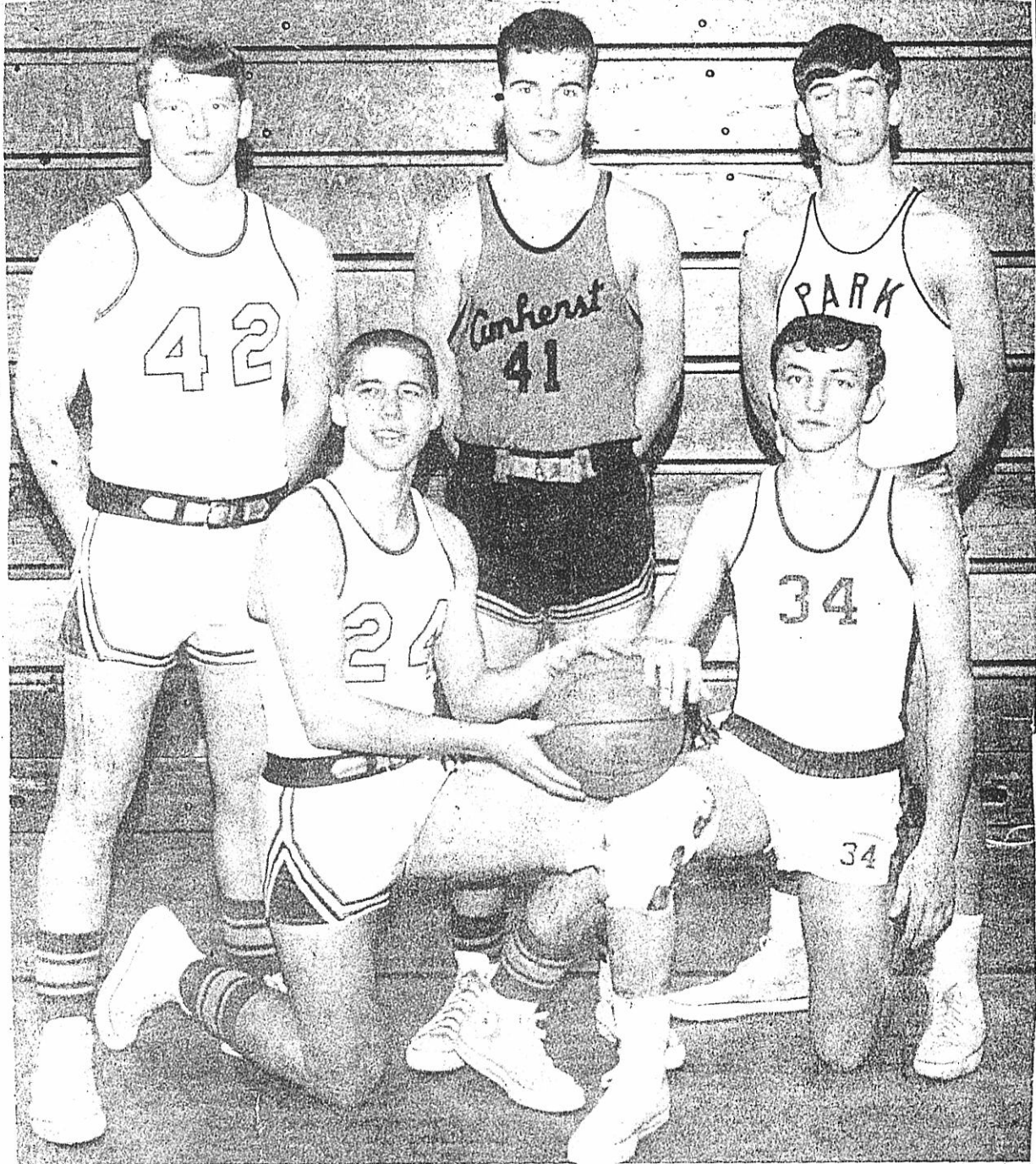
Gary Beebe of Amherst made the other forward position, finishing the season with 238 points for a 13.2 average. Gary went .98 for 260 from the outside for 38% and 42 of 85 from the foul stripe for 49%. He scored 20 points in four different games, 25 being his highest total. Amherst played mostly zone defense this season, so Gary had good position for rebounds which he totaled 175.

TOP FOUL SHOOTER

Keith DiPirro of Williamsville playing in only 12 games because of injuries tallied 180 points but finished second in the area with a 15.0 average. Keith had the best foul shooting average on the team hitting on 52 of 73 for 71%. From the field he made 64 of 171 for 37%. He was a good shooter from close range and a fine ball handler in bringing the ball down court. Keith also was the play-maker for the Billies in setting up plays for Tim Ryan who would have been our sixth All-Star, had we been able to select one more.

The only junior on the quintet is Park School's Jim Morrison. Jim totaled 192 points in 14 games for a 13.7 average, fourth in the area. With another fine showing next season he should make the All-Area "Dream Team" again. Jim shot 37% from the field, 80 of 219 and 64% from the 15-foot marker, 32 of 50. He was a fine rebounder in bringing down 150.

This is his second year of varsity ball. He made the BEE's Honorable Mention last season. Park ended the season with a 5-11 log, 1-7 in league play. Jim scored 107 points in league competition.
