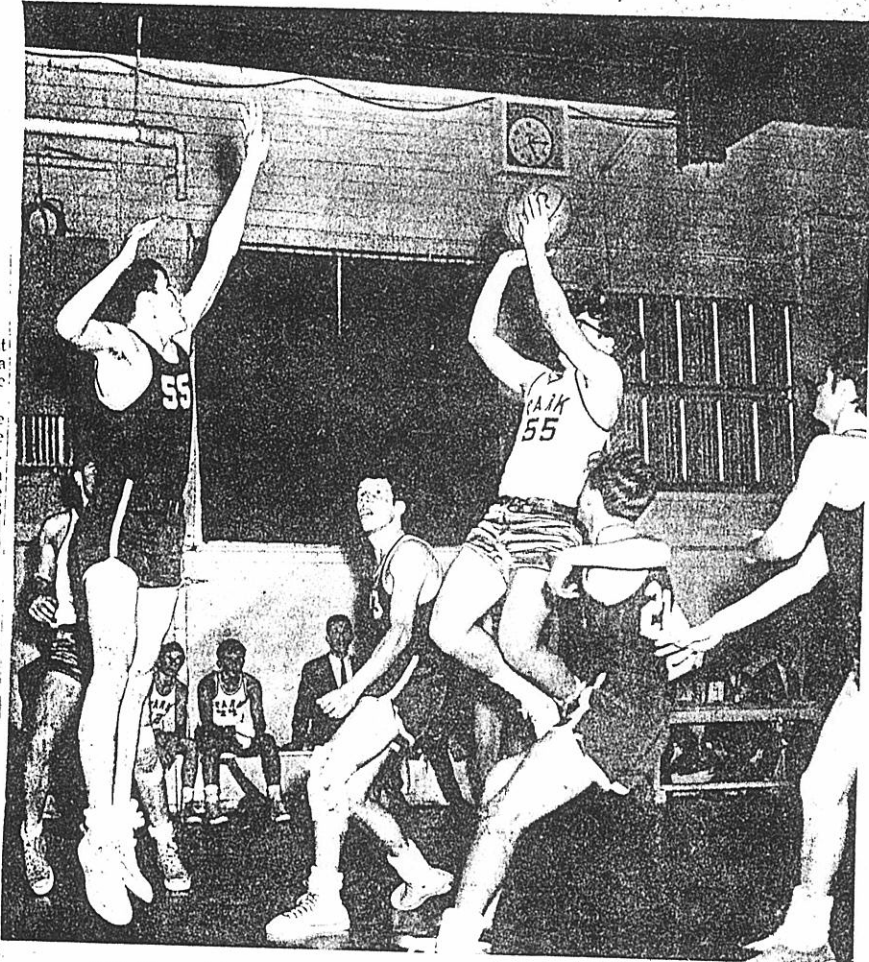

Morrison Nets Final Three Points In Overtime Win

Park School (1-5) finally broke the ice for a win as they eked out a 58-55 overtime victory over Pebble Hill School of Syracuse. This avenged an overtime loss of last year on the same court. The Pioneers jumped to a 17-7 lead in the first quarter as they displayed balance in shooting from all spots on the court and amongst all players. Pebble Hill came back in the second quarter to

narrow the margin to 24-20. After the half, Park again opened the lead to ten but saw Pebble Hill come back to the same 4 point deficit at the end of the quarter. The Hillers then tied it at 37, 39 and 43 and then took the lead only to have Rich Ehrenreich and Jim Morrison match baskets to finally tie the game with a couple seconds left and send the game into overtime. Dave Murray and Pete Sherry made 3 foul shots to give the visitors the lead offset partially by two free throws by John Sheedy. A 3 point play by Sherry made it 55-51 with 1:20 left, but this ended Pebble Hill's scoring. First Sheedy hit on a drive followed by Rich Appel's rebound with 30 seconds left to tie the score. Again with 15 seconds left, Jim Morrison jumped from the side to put Park ahead and caged the final free throw with 4 seconds left as the victory was secured. Sheedy did a fine job on Urb Doehner, the league's high scorer of a year ago, while Jim Morrison had a good night when it counted with his 21 points, and his clutch baskets at the end. Each team is now 1 and 1 in league play, Park travels to Lakemont next weekend. SUMMARIES:
