## PARK SOCCER

The CUPS championship soccer team completed its schedule last week with local contests. On Tuesday a scoreless tie was played at Nichols of Buffalo. Both goalies were untouchable as Park's Pete Yeracaris stopped 20 drives as the host team's Ziemendorf blocked 15 attempts.

Friday's game was likewise a stalemate as Park visited Gow School of South Wales with a 1-1 deadlock resulting, duplicating the result of the earlier contest between the two rivals. Mike Grissom scored in the second period for Gow while Chip Larkin accounted for the equalizer in the third period. Overtimes failed to unlock the standoff.

The Pioneers thus ended their season with a 4-2 winning record in the CUPS league while overall they had 7 wins, 4 ties and but 2 losses. Both defeats occurred in Rochester and both were 1-0. Goalie Yeracaris had 7 shutouts and in the other 6 games he allowed but a single goal. Bernd Zimmerman led the scorers in CUPS play with 5 goals while Chip Larkin totaled 7 overall. Mark Karrer and Gary Vogel added 4 goals apiece for the season.

## Mols and Sevillian Pace Park's Football Victory

ROCHESTER, Oct. 3 — Dave Mols scored four touchdowns and Duane Sevillian two Friday, leading Park School's six-man football team to a 38-7 Conference of Upstate Private Schools victory over Allendale.

Mols scored on a 24-yard pass from Sevillian and runs of 24, 6, and 3 yards. Sevillian tallied on a 70-yard punt return and a 68-yard pass from Mols. In soccer the Pioneers suffered their first CUPS loss, 1-0, to Allendale.

DeVeaux School won its second football game of the season here Saturday afternoon by beating the Park School of Snyder 20-12. The Raiders rolled up 219 yards rushing while holding the Pioneers to only 34 yards on the ground.

Tailback Sandy Graham was the leading rusher in the game with 103 yards in 12 carries. Graham also scored the final Raider touchdown which put the game out of reach.

### Ten Turnovers

The game was marred by ten turnovers which came as the result of fumbles or pass interceptions. Park took advantage of one of these errors in the first quarter to gain control of the ball on the DeVeaux 39. It took the Pioneers eight plays to score with the final 19 yards coming on a pass from Dave Mols to Jeff Rochwarger.

DeVeaux tied the score at 6-6 midway in the second period

plays with Gary Williams going the final three yards on a quarterback sneak.

The first play following the kickoff saw Park fumble the ball away on the DeVeaux 48. The Raiders quickly moved 52 yards for the score with Rick Keros running the last five yards. Keros also ran for the extra point for the 14-6 intermission lead for DeVeaux.

Park took the second half kickoff and moved to the DeVeaux eight before the Raider defense dropped quarterback Mols for a six yard loss to halt the drive. DeVeaux fumbled the ball on the next play and Park was back in business. Park scored five plays later on a one yard run by Mols.

Following a short kickoff DeVeaux moved 52 yards in five plays for the final score of the afternoon. Graham ran 15 yards for the touchdown and the Raiders led 20-12.

## Park Gridders Romp, 55 to 26

Dave Mols passed for six touchdowns and Duane Sevillian scored four on Friday as Park School's undefeated six-man football team posted its fourth victory, beating Limestone, 55-26, on the Park Field.
