Selected for the second year on the all-CUPS six-man football team were end Duane Sevillian and quarterback Dave Mols, plus fullback Mark Cox.

Mols also repeated as high scorer with 74 points, including 12 touchdowns. He threw five TD passes and 2 years ago set the CUPS all-time scoring record of 134 points. Sevillian was third in scoring with 36 markers.

IN SOCCER, halfback Kent Jewett and inside Bernd Zimmerman also repeated. Sophomore Peter Yeracaris, picked as the all-CUPS goalie, posted three shutouts and allowed only one goal in the other three games.

Park's soccer team gained its second leg on the Buffalo Soccer Club title trophy. Zimmerman for the second year was high scorer with 5 goals.
