

## Herb Mols Re-elected Chairman of Amherst Recreation Committee

Following its appointment by the Town Board, the Amherst Recreation Committee met Thursday night, Jan. 31, 1957, to elect officers and discuss its objectives for the coming year. Herbert J. Mols, athletic director at the Park School, and lone Democrat on the committee was re-elected chairman. Mrs. James Nevins was elected secretary and William Christman, corresponding secretary.

Town Attorney Leland G. Davis attended the meeting and outlined the various legal requirements governing the expenditure of town funds and cooperative use of Town and School facilities.

The committee will meet with Councilman D. Russell Conway on Feb. 21 to discuss plans for the Thruway-Royal playground and a standardized set of plans for shelter houses for all playgrounds. At the same meeting Councilman Harry Schall will discuss the problems connected with town maintenance of ice skating facilities.

Chairman Mols announced that the committee would begin screening applicants for the Town Recreation Directorship on March 7, 1957. He requested anyone interested in the job to make prompt application to the Town Board.
