

Town Swim Champions Crowned at Annual Meet

Champions Crowned for 39 Events; Winners Are Listed

After 48 trial heats on Thursday night and 36 finals on Friday night, champions were crowned in 39 events in the fifth annual swim meet, held again at the Park School outdoor pool. Competition was as keen as ever as the record entry left a string of 14 new records in the book. Jim Moore added the backstroke record to the free style record which he set last year, and with Vic Ehre, Dave Brand and Willard Genrich lowered the Pee Wee relay mark. Laurie Baehre set a breast stroke mark and was joined by Penny Bain, Sue Mols and Kathy Scherer in a new relay mark for Pee Wee girls. In the Midgets, Sandy Higgins set a free-style record, Terry Scheeler, a backstroke record, and the team of Barbara Scherer, Beverly Dumke, Pat Postoloff, and Penny Moore established a relay mark.

Judy Devonshire lowered her freestyle mark in the Juniors with her team of Sandy Bain, Sandy Francis and Nori Fessard. Dave McKinnon set a 40 free style record in the intermediate class while Dick Lohr and Don Keel set breast stroke and individual medley marks respectively. Bob Haas set the only senior mark in the individual medley.

Pool-Less Amherst Youths Place Second In Swim Meet

Amherst Sets Good Record at Niagara AAU Meet; Results Listed

Although our town and village are without an outdoor pool, a team of youngsters, brought together mainly from the Town of Amherst Swimming Meet and phone calls, placed second in the annual Niagara AAU age-group swimming meet, held at Lincoln outdoor pool in Kenmore last Tuesday, Aug. 20. The teams were made up of youngsters from Kenmore-Tonawanda, Tonawanda-North Tonawanda, and Williamsville-Amherst. Each team entered two youngsters in each event and points were scored 5, 3, 2, 1 for the first four places.

In all, our boys and girls, ranging in age from 10 and under thru 16, did exceedingly well, cracking six records. Dave McKinnon, Don Keel, and Jim Moore scored individual records while the other three records were made by relay teams. The team of Dick Bruehl, Dave Brand, Bill Genrich, and Carl Ullrich with a time of 1:23.3, set one record in the 100 meter freestyle relay; Veronica Domster, Beverly Dumke, Sandy Higgins, and Penny Moore with a time of 3:01.1 in the 200 meter freestyle relay set another and the team of Penny Bain, Judy Hurd, Judy Eckert, and Barbara Jacobi with the time of 1:34.5 established the other record in the 100 meter freestyle relay.
