

# Town Of Amherst Swim Champions are Crowned

## Winners Listed for Sixth Annual Meet; Event Drew 159 Entries

Champions were crowned last Thursday and Friday in the 6th annual Town of Amherst Swim Meet held at the Park School outdoor pool. Meet Director Herbert J. Mols revealed an entry of 159 which showed an increased interest in the younger age groups, although the senior group dropped to its lowest ebb. The quality continued to improve as the trials saw five records broken and one tied, while the finals listed 13 new records and another tied. Councilman Cook represented the Town in the presentation of medals while members of the service clubs made their special awards for the relays.

Co-director Eob Bedell will now join with Herb Mols to select the team which will represent Amherst-Williamsville against the Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda team in the annual meet at Lincoln Pool next Wednesday, Aug. 27. The selections will be made from the Junior Olympic representatives, as well as this Town meet.

Don Keel predominated in the Senior class by copping three events with Frank Hahn garnering the 100 backstroke. Keel tied the oldest record in the book, :20.5, in the 40 free set by Karl Seidl in 1953. Brenda Mols captured the Senior Girls' 40 free for the second straight year.

Don Bird set a record for the Intermediate 40 free of :21.2 and also won the 60-yard individual medley as well as teaming with Richard Lohr, Steve Cochrane, and Dick Keel on the winning relay team. Lohr set a new 100-yard breaststroke mark of 1:20, while Cochrane lowered the backstroke mark to 1:09.4. Ann Marcille and Judy Devonshire lowered the girls' 40 breaststroke and 40 backstroke marks, respectively.

Dick Haas set a new Junior breaststroke record of :29.8 and then joined with Joe Chimera, Frank Moore, and Craig Bruehl for a relay record.

Pete Kerber scored an upset win in the Midget 40 free in record-breaking time of :23.6 and was joined by Jim Moore, Larry Robinson, and Gary Mols in a record-breaking relay. Larry Baehre smashed his own breaststroke record, set the night before, in :16.6.

Pat Dudley tied the 20-yard freestyle record on Thursday night only to have Barbara Jacobi nose her out in the finals. Sue Mols set a new breaststroke record, and with Barbara, Marilyn Dumke, and Sharon Sanders, set a new relay standard. Susan Hober established a new backstroke record for the new event. Dale Neuberger was the only PeeWee boy to break a record as he set his mark in the backstroke.
