

Amherst Championship Swim Set Aug. 13-14

The seventh annual championship swimming meet for residents of the Town of Amherst will be held Thursday and Friday, August 13 and 14, at the Park School's outdoor pool. Herbert J. Mols, Park School athletic director and originator of the meet, will again serve as official.

Entries must be sent to 99 Chateau Ter., Snyder 26, by no later than Friday, August 12. None postmarked after that date will be accepted. Performances at this meet have to help select the team to represent Amherst-Williamsville in the annual competition at the Lincoln Park pool between teams from Kenmore, Tonawanda and North Tonawanda.

All swimmers must appear August 13 to qualify in the trials, if necessary. All the finals will be contested August 14.

Rochester's Boddie Wins AAU Decathlon Crown

Richie Boddie of Rochester Sunday won the Niagara District AAU Decathlon Track Championships at Williamsville High School. Boddie scored 4357 points in ten events in two days to edge Buffalo's Isaac Bolden with 4201.

Defending champion Paul Amato of the University of Buffalo finished fifth with 3243 behind the Gardentown Track Club's Lee Martin, 3312, and Frank Finnerty, 3424. Boddie's winning events Sunday were the pole vault, 9½ feet; the javelin throw, 139½ feet, and a tie with Bolden in the 110-meter high hurdles at 16.3 seconds.
